




### **Healing the Warrior's Heart DVD**

A one-hour video examining the emotional trauma of war through the prism of Native American tradition and ceremony. Much of the documentary focuses on members of the Blackfeet tribe in northern Montana and includes interviews and scenes with native spiritual leaders, veterans from the wars in Iraq and Afghanistan, elder veterans, family members and tribal leaders. Narrated by Peter Coyote. Produced by the Western Folklife Center's Taki Telonidis, in collaboration with Gary Robinson of Tribal Eye Productions and KUED Channel 7-Salt Lake City, Utah.




